THE CARTIER STRATEGY UNCOVER AND DELIVER VALUE

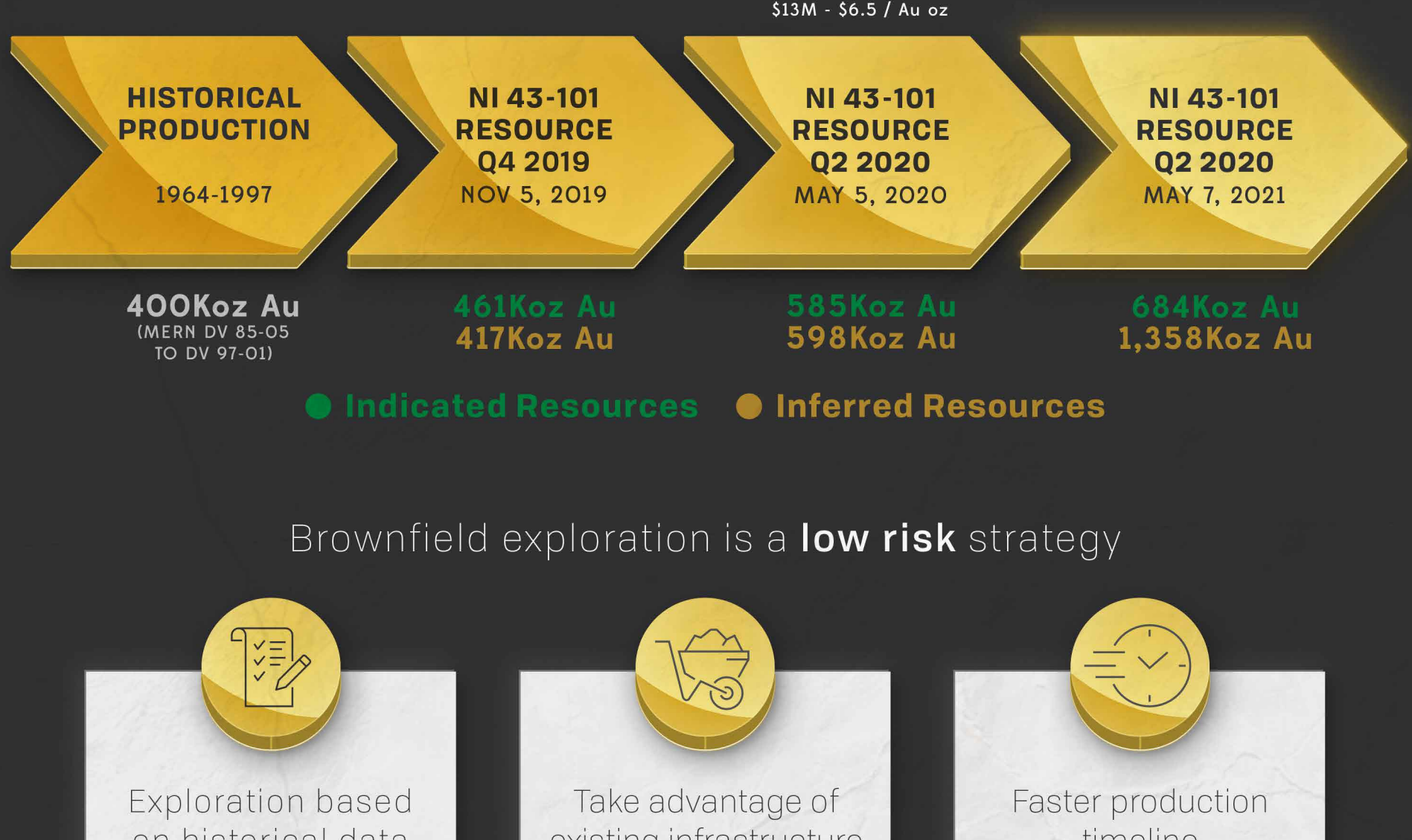
Cartier sees value in historic projects where others don't.

Brownfield exploration is the practice of exploring areas near previously-discovered mineral deposits and adding ounces through exploration.



Brownfield exploration is a **low risk** strategy

- Exploration based on historical data
- Take advantage of existing infrastructure
- Faster production timeline

THE PROOF THE CHIMO MINE PROJECT

This strategy has led Cartier to multiple well-established gold-bearing properties in the Abitibi, including the **Chimo Mine project**.

The most recent resource estimate calculates gold in the Chimo mine at:

684,000oz Au* Indicated **1,358,000oz Au*** Inferred

*6,616,000 tonnes at an average grade of 3.21 g/t Au

*15,240,000 tonnes at an average grade of 2.77 g/t Au

On May 7, 2021, Cartier Resources expanded its indicated resource by **17%** and inferred resource by **127%**.

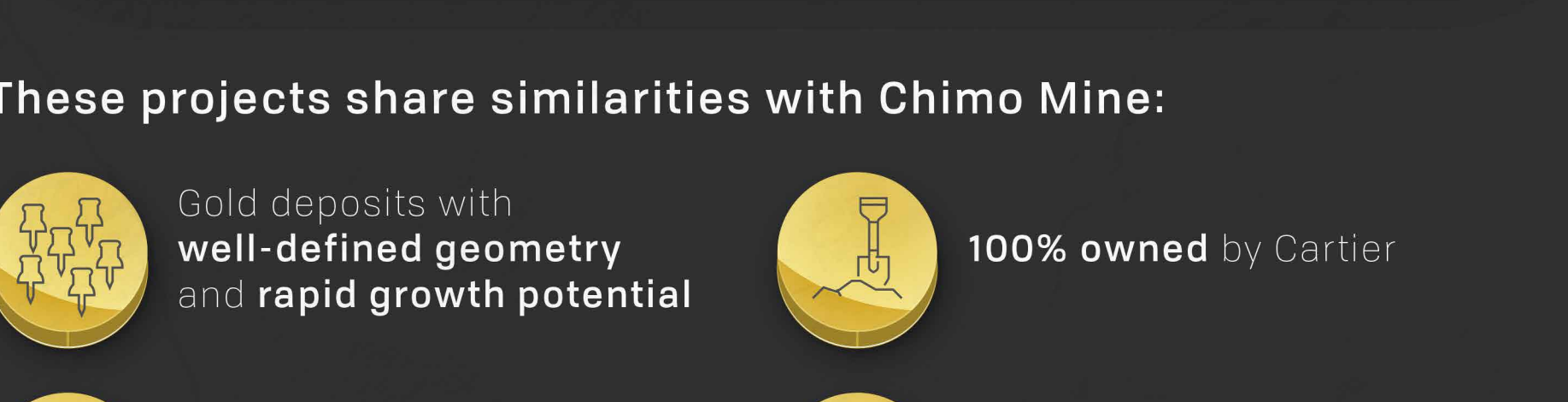
